Wyoming Stock Growers Association, Wyoming Farm Bureau Federation, and Utah Farm Bureau Federation (collectively, "Agricultural Associations"), by and through their undersigned counsel, Mountain States Legal Foundation, by Cody J. Wisniewski, respectfully move this Court for entry of an Order granting this Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment ("Motion") against Plaintiff Center for Biological Diversity ("CBD") and denying Plaintiff CBD's *Motion for Summary Judgment*, ECF No. 54.

This Motion is supported by Agricultural Associations' *Brief in Support of Wyoming Stock Growers Association, Wyoming Farm Bureau Federation, and Utah Farm Bureau Federation's Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment and Response to Center for Biological Diversity's Motion for Summary Judgment and Wyoming Stock Growers Association, Wyoming Farm Bureau Federation, and Utah Farm Bureau Federation's Response to Plaintiff's Statement of Undisputed Facts, filed concurrently herewith, as well as the previously filed and supplemented Administrative Record, ECF Nos. 39, 53.*

Agricultural Associations oppose each and every claim for relief set forth by Plaintiff CBD in its Motion for Summary Judgment. In order to promote judicial efficiency and to comply with this Court's Orders dated January 6, 2020, and March 20, 2020, ECF Nos. 40, 48, Agricultural Associations will only specifically address arguments that are particularly relevant to them given their vast amount of

experience with and exposure to the lower-48 grizzly bear population and its recovered distinct population segments, but also with the broader issues surrounding the now-unwieldy Endangered Species Act and purported Administrative Procedure Act requirements.

Pursuant to D. Mont. L.R. 7.1(c)(1), counsel for Agricultural Associations has contacted counsel for the other parties regarding their position on this Motion. Counsel for Plaintiff CBD indicated they oppose the relief requested in this Motion. Counsel for Federal Defendants and other Intervenor-Defendants indicated they do not oppose this Motion.

WHEREFORE, Intervenor-Defendants Wyoming Stock Growers
Association, Wyoming Farm Bureau Federation, and Utah Farm Bureau Federation
respectfully pray for the following relief:

- 1. That this Court enter an Order GRANTING this Cross-Motion for Summary Judgment and DENYING Plaintiff Center for Biological Diversity's motion for summary judgment; and
- 2. For such other and further relief as this Court deems equitable and proper.
